IV. ELIGIBILITY POLICY

Mr. Preut is recommending the following be considered for approval:

Proposal 1:

In order to be eligible to participate in USD 377 sponsored athletics/activities, beginning with the Fall semester of 2005, students must have earned a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average. This cumulative grade point average will only include semester grades and will be calculated beginning with the Fall 2005 semester. Students who do not have a cumulative semester grade point average of at least 2.0 at the end of each semester will be ineligible to participate in USD 377 athletics/activities the following semester in accordance with KSHSAA guidelines. *Students who appear on the D/F list may be required to participate in academic assistance activities. Students “not in good standing” because of Code of Conduct violations can be restricted from participating in USD 377 sponsored athletics/activities.*

Highlights:

- All students held to same standard regardless of year of graduation
- GPA same as for graduation: cumulative and 2.0
- Grades based on semester rather than progress reports
- Includes mandatory academic assistance and conduct
- KSHSAA guidelines allow students to practice but do not allow interscholastic participation

Proposal 2:

In order to be eligible to participate in USD 377 sponsored athletics/activities, beginning with the Fall semester of 2005, students must have earned a minimum 2.0 semester grade point average. This grade point average will only include semester grades and will be calculated beginning with the Fall 2005 semester. Students who do not have a semester grade point average of at least 2.0 at the end of each semester will be ineligible to participate in USD 377 athletics/activities the following semester in accordance with KSHSAA guidelines. *Students who appear on the D/F list may be required to participate in academic assistance activities. Students “not in good standing” because of Code of Conduct violations can be restricted from participating in USD 377 sponsored athletics/activities.*

Highlights:

- All students held to same standard regardless of year of graduation
- GPA same as for graduation but semester by semester not cumulative
- GPA is not cumulative which means students must maintain a C average each semester. They cannot do well one semester and “coast” the next.
- Grades based on semester rather than progress reports
- Includes mandatory academic assistance and conduct
- KSHSAA guidelines allow students to practice but do not allow interscholastic participation
