What's Happening?

Math

Students will demonstrate knowledge of the basic division facts. They will also demonstrate the ability to solve one and two-step problems relating to real world concepts.

Students will be working on improving their speed with basic multiplication and division facts. Practice those flashcards at home!

Writing/English

Students will use the standard writing conventions while writing their next story for the October "Tiger Tracks." They will be writing a book sketch and a spooky Halloween story for the next newsletter.

Reading
