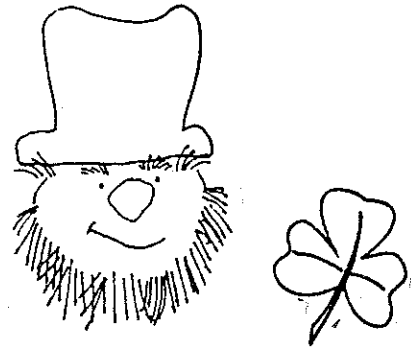

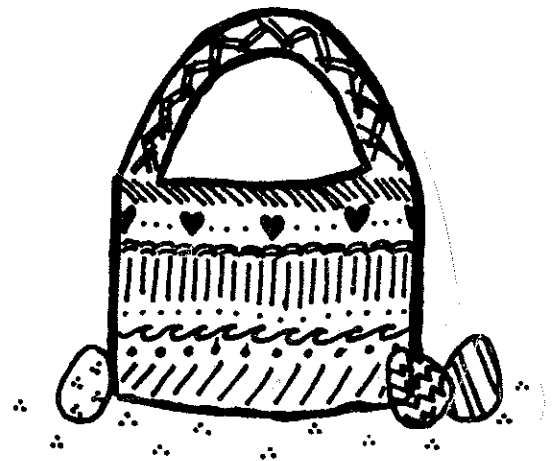

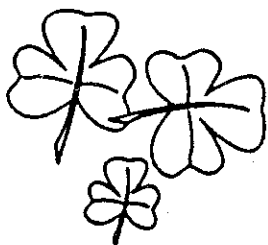
### HAPPY BIRTHDAY GWENDOLYN
