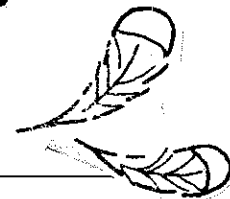

READING, GRAMMAR, SPELLING

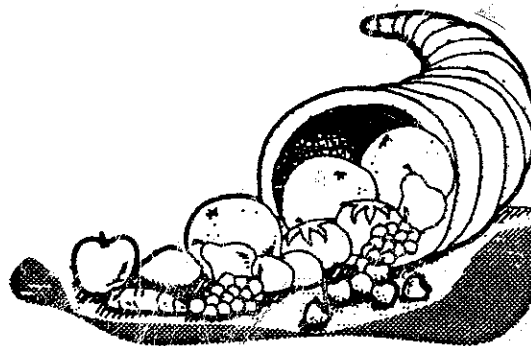

BOOK ORDERS

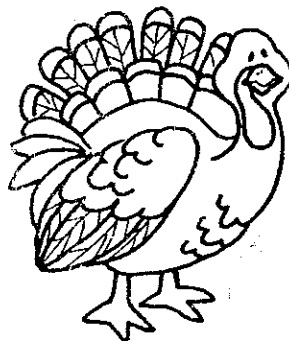
