The meeting was called to order at 6 PM by Mr. Sack. Minutes from the last meeting (6/7/06) were read. Jeanette Martin moved, Janice Reiss second to accept minutes. Motion carried.

Old Business:

- *Mr. Sack would like us to think about community members and business leaders that would be Potential SITE Council members. Please submit names to Mr. Sack.
- *Communication: We have heard positive responses to the ACCMS Daily Announcements and Tiger Growls that are going out as e-mail.
- *After School Program: It will be focusing on Reading on Mondays and Wednesdays, and on Math On Tuesdays and Thursday. Rather than a time for homework to be done, After-School has become More of an extended teaching time. Mrs. Worley and Mrs. Logan are the instructors.
- *MAP Testing will begin next week. The results should give some indication as to how students May perform on the State Assessments.
- *AYP: Due to our low number of students, the State lumped all of our SPED students into 1 group Rather than divide them by classes. As a result of the regrouping, the State has determined that Our SPED students met AYP.
- *Student Survey: Mr. Sack will be getting the results of this to us at the next meeting.
- *Student Council: It consists of 12 members, with Mr. Sack serving as the only adult advisor at this Time. He would welcome another adult advisor. Student Council is currently working on guidelines
- *District Facility Report: Linda Boos reported that the Committee met last week, they would like to Add new members to their committee also. They discussed the Sports Complex. A Feasibility Study Should be ready and presented to the Board at the November Board Meeting.
- *No Technology or Steering Committee report.

New Business:

- *Power School: This program allows parents to access their students' academic progress via the Internet. Hopefully it will be up and running by Christmas Break.
- *Mr. Sack would like us to take time to review the list of important issues that was compiled at the June meeting.
- *SITE Council would like to look at Staffing Models for ACCMS, with particular note to PE and Computers. The Council believes there is a lack of teacher staffing at ACCMS.
- *Mr. Sack would like us to let him know what issues we would like to discuss at our next meeting.
- *Lori Scholz was present as a guest at the meeting. Eileen Montgomery moved to accept Lori as a SITE Council member, Sharon Worley second. Motion Carried.
