

ACCMS PTO meeting
January 16, 2007
7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by President Jan Reiss with Mr. Sack and 10 members present.

Becky Miller read the Secretary's report from November 20, 2006, and it was approved. She noted preparing the movie day popcorn took too long to pop just starting at noon. With the classes participating at various times throughout the day, it was suggested that next year PTO provide fruit snacks, or something less time intensive.

Treasurer's report was given by Teresa Atzenweiler:

1. Review of expenditures and receipts since last PTO meeting, with balance of \$4,391.49 reported. It was moved, seconded and motion carried to accept the treasurer's report.
2. After the Snow Creek ski trip 2nd quarter positive party was approved during this meeting, the balance will be \$3,248.49. Activities supported by PTO since last meeting include movie day, snack and drink for students and staff before Christmas break, and 2nd quarter positive party ski trip \$1,143, with 209 students attending, of which 37 did not ski.
3. It was noted that PTO did not provide a treat for the teachers' in-service day on Jan 15, 2007.

Mr. Sack:

1. Mentioned district plans to offer "Advanced" courses in middle and high school, High School orientation meetings for 8th grade students and parents, district self-reported KSHSAA violation of boys basketball practice during break, consideration of dress code changes, developing a District Activities Handbook for all activities in middle and high school.
2. Completion of office space on 1st floor was approved by Board of Education.

Concession Stand:

1. Still need volunteers for Boys basketball and Track. Will send letter with MS daily announcements.
2. With approval of BOE to complete 1st floor office space, closet used by PTO will need to be arranged differently. Teresa Atzenweiler will meet with Mr. Sack and Dan Coder to determine what PTO needs to change. Also will address the hard to open lock.

Science Fair: Mr. Porter asked, as presented by Teresa Atzenweiler, if PTO would purchase the science boards the students will use at the Science Fair this spring. By purchasing in bulk and providing to all students, consistency in appearance and durability is maintained. 175 boards at \$2.65 estimated cost per board, maximum cost \$455. It was moved, seconded and motion carried to fund purchase of science boards for this year's Science Fair.

Next treat for students was discussed. Decided to provide peanut butter no bake cornflake cookies and vanilla ice cream to students and staff with lunch on Valentine's Day. Teresa will order from Sisters Cooking and Schwan's. Students will complete Kansas State Assessments by April 20, 2007, and PTO will provide some treat after that time. Next year may consider a Kansas Day treat instead.

Next meeting scheduled for Monday, February 19, 2007, beginning at 7:00 p.m.
