ELIGIBILITY:

Children who have reached or will reach the age of four by August 31, 2006 are eligible.

LITTLE PAWS:

Children must meet certain criteria to qualify for the At-Risk Program.

1. Single parent family
2. Teenage parent
3. Developmentally or academically delayed

TIGER PAWS:

Children aged 4 or 5 may attend. Five year olds who are not ready for Kindergarten will be accepted into this program.

ENROLLMENT:

ALTERNATE START:

All Preschool and Kindergarten classes alternate days of attendance the first two weeks of school. More information will be available after enrollment.
