Varsity Boys Basketball Team Defeats JCN to Win McLouth Mid-Season Tournament!

Ryan Martin named to the All-Tournament Team and Austin Eckert named Tournament MVP!

The ACCHS boy's basketball team were named champions of the 23<sup>rd</sup> annual McLouth Mid-season tournament as they defeated JCN Saturday evening in the nightcap game 71-38. This is the second championship for the Tigers in the past two years. In the championship game the Tigers were hot as they jumped out to an 18-2 lead after the first quarter. They never looked back holding the Chargers to eight in the second quarter while putting up 21 points of their own, going into halftime with a 29 point lead. In the third quarter the Tigers were able to keep the momentum going outscoring JCN 19-12. Leading scorers for the Tigers were Ryan Martin with 19, Austin Eckert with 17 and Mitchel Kurtz with 9. Starting point guard, Riley Hundley effectively contributed while dishing out eight assists, 3 steals and 3 defensive boards. In the first round of the tournament the Tigers defeated Valley Falls 64-49 and Cair Paravel in the semi-final game Friday evening 68-39. All the Tigers contributed to the success of the tournament with the leadership of the seniors, Clint Corpstein, Steven Rathert, Trevor Lutz, Marvin Sun Leuh, Josh Keimig and Jake Reiss. Ryan Martin and Austin Eckert were named to the All tournament team and Eckert was named the Tournament MVP. ACCHS currently is 8 and 3 overall on the season.
