Board Meeting Highlights from Monday, April 26, 2010 – Extended Session

Tuesday, April 27, 2010

- **Approved the FY'10 K-12 At-Risk and Vocational Education republished budgets.**
  - K-12 At-Risk –\$485,853
  - Vocational Education –\$193,000
- Approved the offer from the City of Lancaster of \$750 for Lancaster building and property.
- Rejected the offer of \$30,000 from John Bechtold for the Cummings building and property.
- **Approved Creal Clark & Seifert to develop renovation drawings for the JSH girls' restroom at a cost of \$1300.**
- Adopted a resolution for 5-year Capital Outlay mill levy of eight (8) mills.
- Approved the low bid of \$35,645.45 from Allegiant Networks for equipment hardware and software to consolidate the district servers into one data center using a virtualization platform.
- Approved a change order in the amount of \$1,631 to install additional electrical outlets in the new tech classroom being constructed this summer in the old HS woodshop – what is now the A+ Learning lab.
- Approved the request from the Atchison County 4-H Council to use a district school bus to transport 4-H members to 4-H camp at Rock Springs this summer.
- Approved the request from Mr. Preut and Mr. Wetig to reward students in grades 6, 7, 8, and 11 with two days off for achieving Standard of Excellence goals on the reading and math state assessments.
- Approved 2010-2011 KASB membership dues (\$7,659) and KASB Legal Assistance Dues (\$1,400).
- Accepted a gift of \$2,716.42 from the elementary PTO for elementary field trips.
- Accepted the resignation of Mr. Hinrichs who has accepted a superintendent position in Loup City, Nebraska.
- Adopted a resolution to non-renew Vicki Hegarty and authorized the superintendent to renegotiate a new contract for 2010-2011.
- Adopted a resolution to non-renew two long-term substitutes – Mr. Harrison and Mr. Cormode.
